SEO Scholars Program Quick Facts

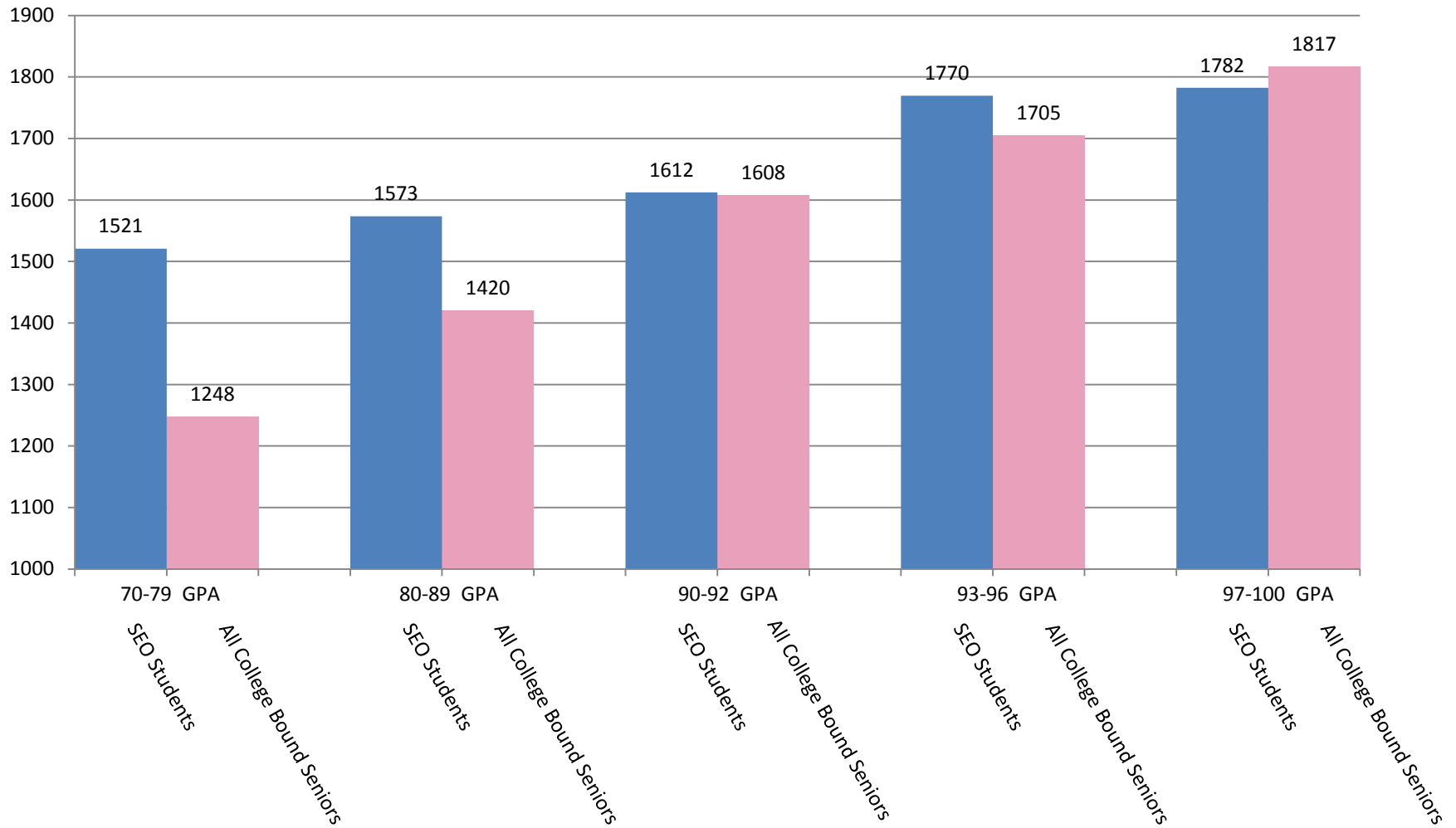
- The SEO Scholars Program is an Out-of-School-Time (OST) academic program serving urban public high school students in NYC and San Francisco
- Scholars Program currently serves 365 public high school students attending more than 100 high schools.
- During grades 9-12, SEO Scholars attend 720 hours of OST instruction in critical reading, critical writing, vocabulary, grammar, and math.
- SEO Scholars participate in SEO's Saturday Academy, after-school sessions and summer program.
- Classroom instruction is based on SEO's curriculum and led by SEO's part-time faculty.
- SEO partners with local universities to provide classroom space for its Saturday Academy and summer program.
- ***In 2009 & 2010, SEO Black high school seniors outperformed White college-bound seniors nationally on SAT scores at virtually every in-school GPA level, effectively eliminating the academic achievement gap for SEO participants.***
- The average cumulative GPA of all 193 SEO College Scholars in Spring 2010 was 3.12 and approximately 90% were on track for on-time college graduation.

SEO Scholars Compared to All College Bound Seniors 2009 & 2010 SAT Results

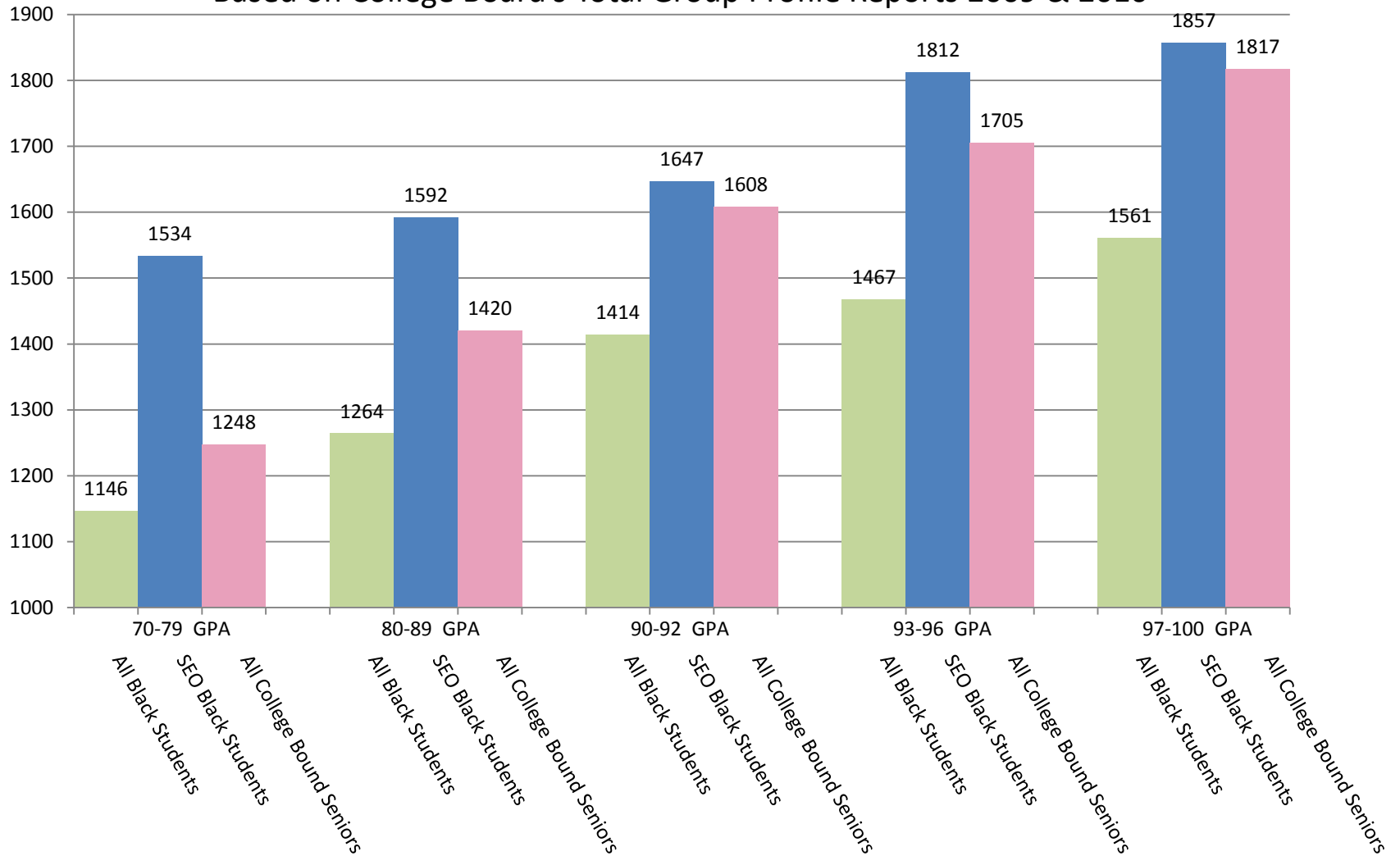
By Grade Point Average

SEO Black Scholars Compared to All College Bound Seniors 2009 & 2010 SAT Results By Grade Point Average 2400 Point Scale

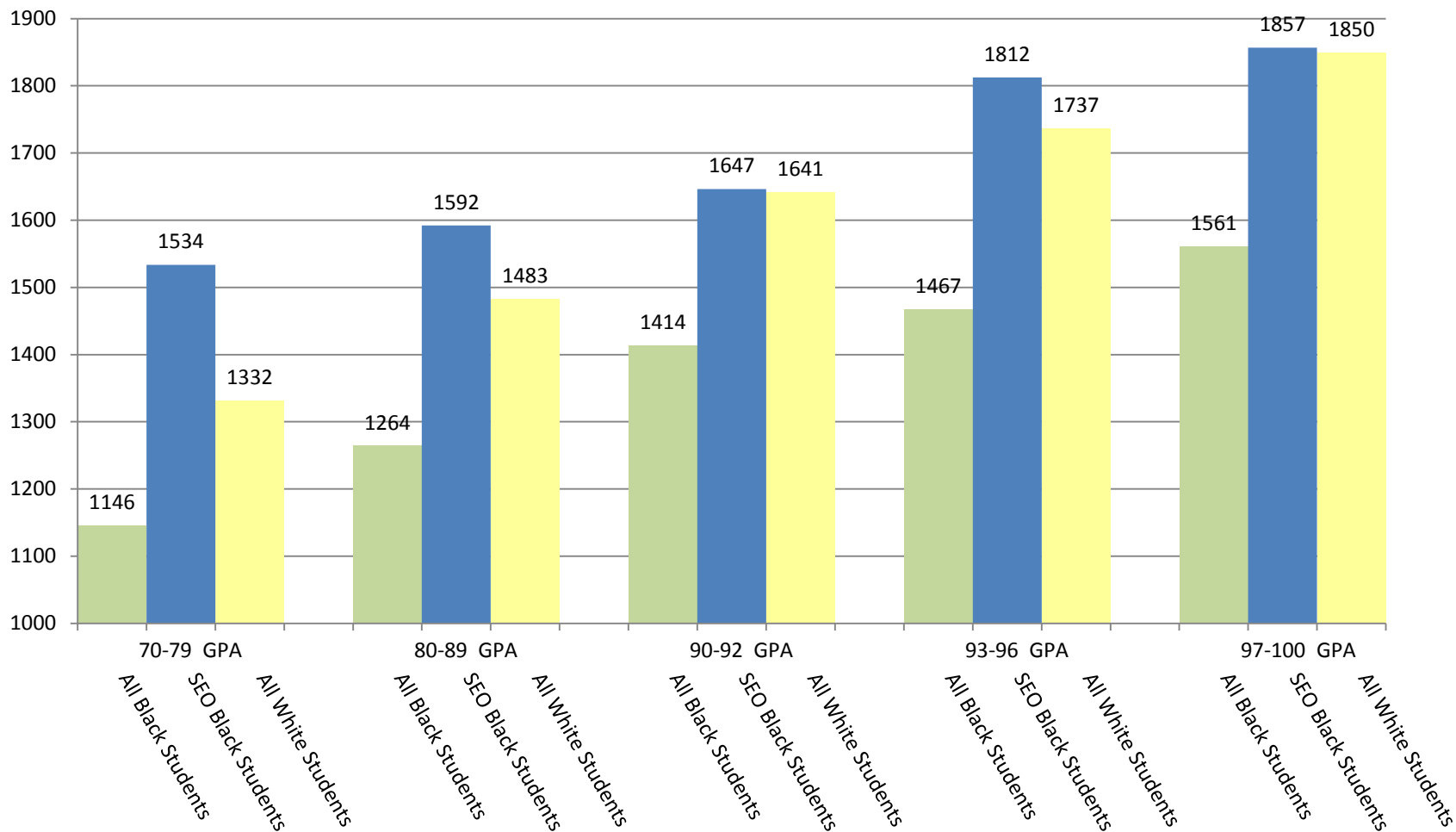

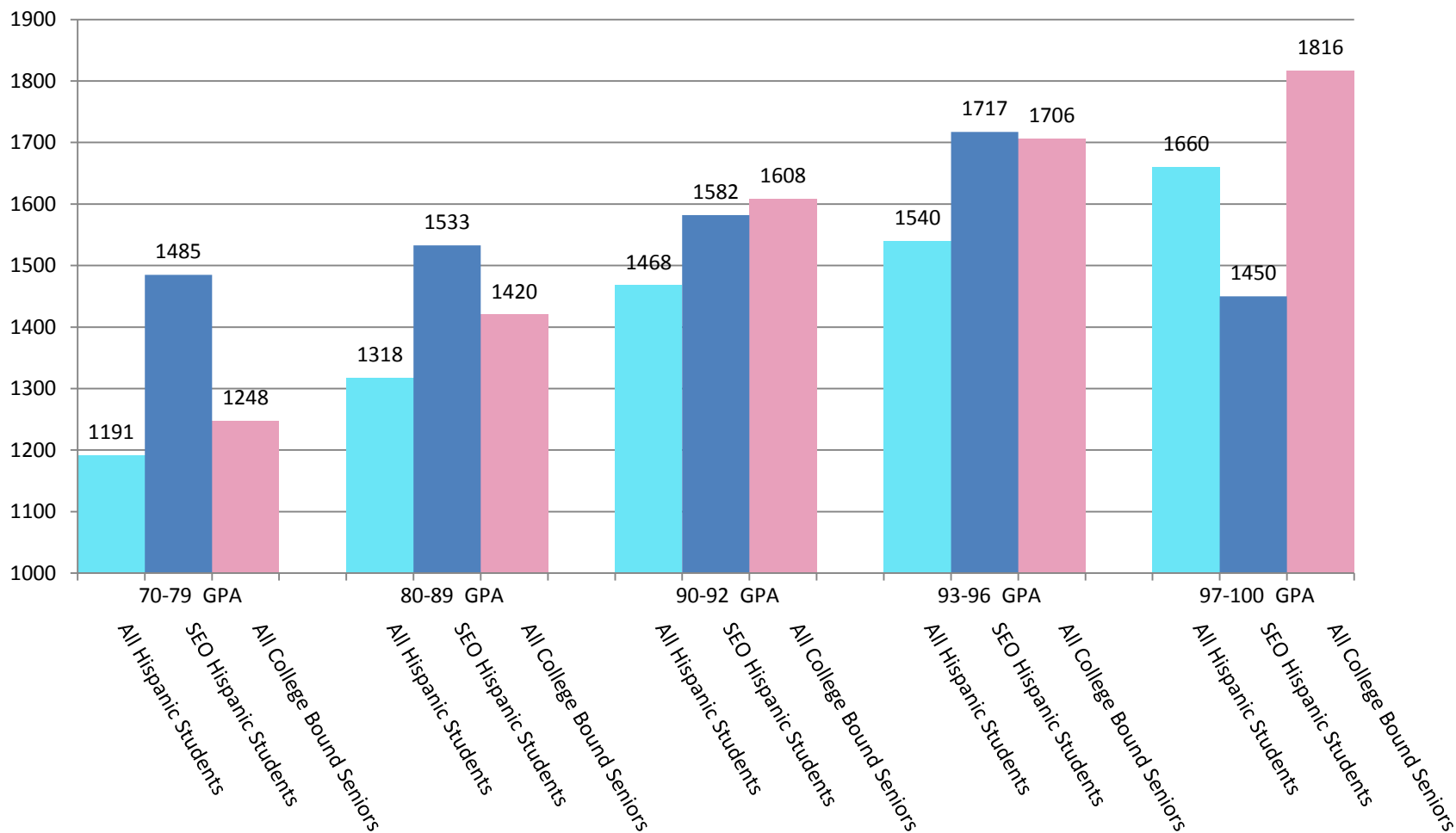


SEO Hispanic Scholars Compared to All College Bound Seniors 2009 & 2010 SAT Results

2400 Point Scale

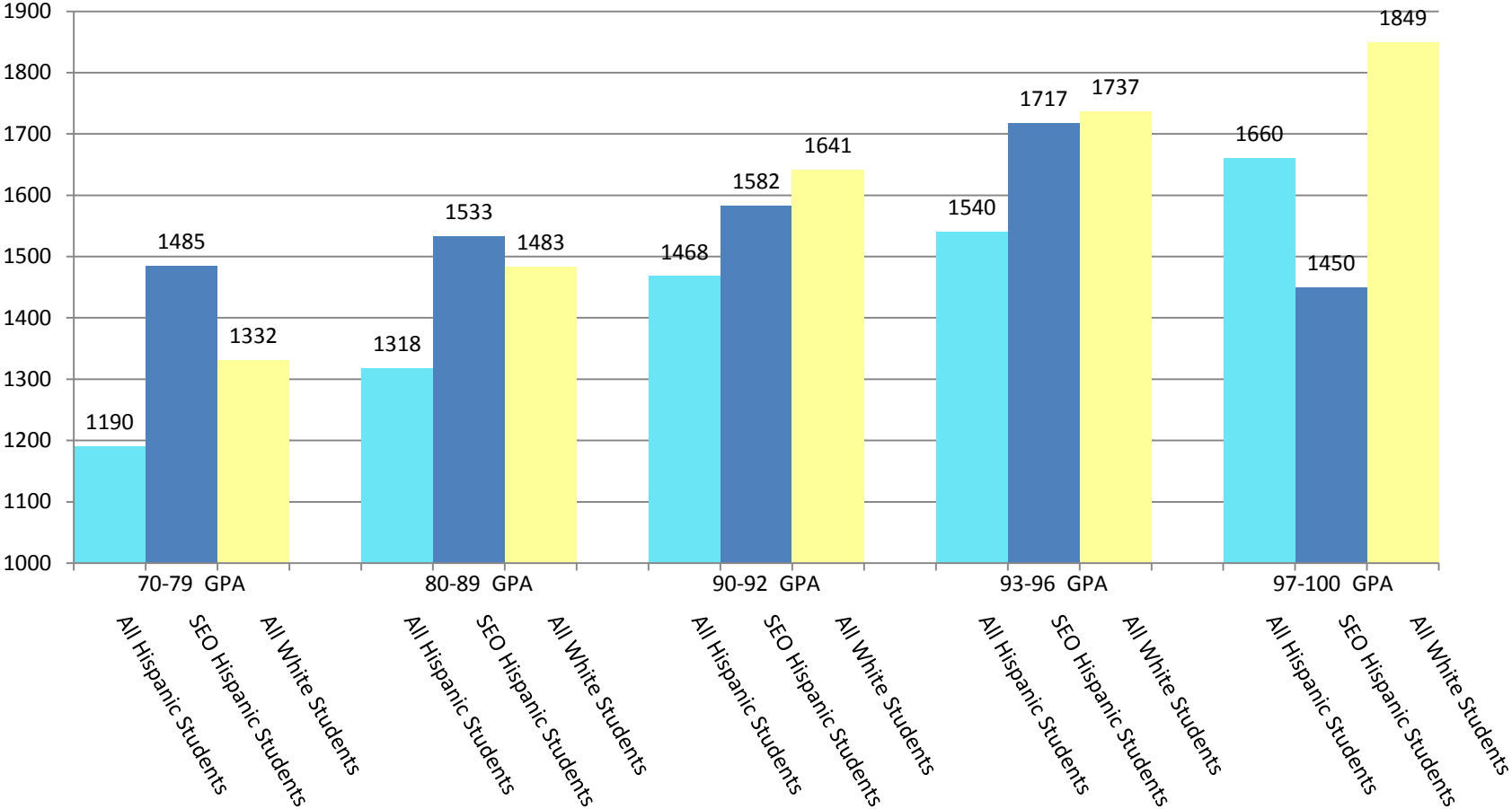
